Ten years of monitoring the resilience of the Chaco forest in Córdoba, Argentina



The seminar will be held in the lecture room of the Department of Botany (Botanical villa) on Tuesday June 24th at 3:30 pm.

Lucrecia is a researcher from the IMBIV institute (CONICET) and an assistant professor in the National University of Córdoba, Argentina. She is part of the “Diversity and sustainability group” led by Professor Sandra Díaz. Her research evaluates the responses of plant communities in the Chaco forest to disturbances related to land use change, especially focusing on the resilience framework. She started the monitoring of this ecosystem during her PhD and has continued it during the past 10 years.
